

Carbon Reduction Plan

Commitment to achieving net zero

A. Hammond & Sons Limited is committed to achieving net zero emissions by 2050.

The business recognises the need to rapidly decarbonise the construction and building industry, and has produced this Carbon Reduction Plan to set out how it will meet that target. We will report on our progress annually and this plan will be reviewed and republished at least once every twelve months.

A. Hammond & Sons Limited is a construction company providing a full construction service, including new-build, alteration, refurbishment, conversion, restoration, maintenance and repairs, to both the public and private sectors in the South West of the United Kingdom.

Baseline emissions footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured. We will report on our progress to Net Zero annually.

Baseline year: 1 November 2024 – 31 October 2025

Additional details relating to the baseline emissions calculations

A. Hammond & Sons Limited has not previously assessed or reported its greenhouse gas emissions. In accordance with the guidance accompanying the Carbon Reduction Plan template, this first reporting period has been adopted as our baseline year, and the baseline year and current reporting year are therefore the same.

Emissions reduction targets

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 128.09 tCO₂e by 2030, a reduction of 25% against the baseline year.

Diesel used by our vehicle fleet and mobile plant accounts for 64% of our reported emissions and travel to and between sites for a further 22%. Our targets are therefore focused on progressive replacement of diesel vans with electric vehicles as the fleet comes up for renewal, and on reducing the energy demand of our premises.

Carbon reduction projects

Environmental management measures

The following environmental management measures are in place:

- Site waste management planning, with waste streams segregated on site and recycling and recovery rates monitored through waste transfer documentation. In the baseline year 92.1% of waste arisings were recycled or recovered rather than landfilled.
- Use of a local supply chain. On a recent Blandford Forum contract materials were supplied from merchant branches at a weighted average round trip of 4.4 miles from site.
- Segregation of timber, plasterboard, metals, plastics and cardboard for recycling rather than mixed disposal.

Future carbon reduction initiatives

- New head office facility at Blandford Forum, with solar photovoltaic panels, a thermally efficient building fabric, LED lighting and rainwater harvesting.
- Progressive replacement of diesel vans with electric vehicles, with charging infrastructure at the new facility.
- Plug-in solar panels for site offices and welfare units.

A detailed timeline will be agreed and reported in the next annual review of this plan.

Declaration and sign off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 006 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard and uses the appropriate government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting.

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements (where required), and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard.

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been reviewed and signed off by the board of directors (or equivalent management body).
